Our dearly beloved Saint Pope John Paul II, in his last and final statement, expressed to the world the great importance and the urgency to understand and accept Our Lord's incredible gift of Divine Mercy. He said to all the people of the world:

"As a gift to humanity, which sometimes seems bewildered and overwhelmed by the power of evil. selfishness, and fear, the Risen Lord offers His love that pardons, reconciles, and reopens hearts to love. It is love that converts hearts and gives peace. How much the world needs to understand and accept Divine Mercy! Lord, who reveal the Father's love by Your Death and Resurrection, we believe in You and confidently repeat to You...

Jesus, I trust in You, have mercy upon us and upon the whole world. Amen."

The Church celebrates Easter for a full 8 days which culminates on the Octave Day of Easter, on the following Sunday. I firmly believe that Saint Pope John Paul II decreed this special plenary indulgence because he firmly believed that the Divine Floodgates of Heaven are open on that day and he wanted everybody to take advantage of it.
